Do you screen manuscripts, and what kind of material do you accept?

We're looking for manuscripts that are well-written, interesting and professionally edited. Other than pornography, obscene material, hate literature, anti-religious literature and anything illegal, all subjects are welcome. You should own the copyright to all your material, or seek permission from its owners. We do screen manuscripts. As much as we'd like to help every potential author who comes along, we want to be proud of what we publish, because every Epic Press author is proud to have our imprint on their book.

Do I have to sign an exclusive contract?

No. We are a publishing services provider. You own your copyright, not us. You are free to take your book wherever you want, whenever you want.

How long does the whole process take?

Around 4 to 8 weeks from signing the Publishing Agreement. There are things that can affect your book's timeline, such as complex layout, lots of pictures or tables, making additions and corrections after we accept your final manuscript, etc. But most authors are holding the first copy of their book in their hands in less than 2 months from submission.

Who sets the cover price of my book?

It's important to us that our books are priced competitively in the market. We provide Book Pricing guidelines, below which we cannot charge for a book due to the production cost. These guidelines are very competitive but it's up to you how you want to price your book according to your assessment of your books market.

How much will I earn?

New authors earn 22% of their book's retail price. Your personal royalties increase up to 32% as you and your referred authors sell more and more books. Additionally you will begin receiving significant bonuses from Epic Press when you successfully recommend us to other budding authors. See Royalties for details.

How often are authors paid?

Authors receive monthly sales reports at the end of the month reporting sales for the previous month (i.e. sales reports are 30-days delayed.) Reports are accompanied by a bank transfer or cheque every 60 days in which your account balance is greater than £25. Those with less than £25 are carried over to the next 60 days, until they reach £25.

If I refer an author to you, what do I get out of it?

Firstly, their future book sales will be counted as part of your 'Total Retail Sales Value'. This accelerates your progress to Gold and Platinum status where you earn significantly higher royalties of 27% and 32% respectively. In addition, until your referred authors reach your status, you will receive a bonus from Epic Press on every book that they sell. This bonus is around 5% and up to 10% of the Retail List Price of their book sales. Consider it a thank you from us for helping us grow and build our company.

What is 'Total Retail Sales Value'?

This is the cumulative total of your book sales, your referred authors book sales, their referred authors book sales, and their referred authors book sales... and so on. In time, this figure will tot up quite substantially and probably through the sales activity of authors who you don't even know. The point is that at the £500 threshold, you become a Gold author, and at £5000, you graduate to elite Platinum status. This allows you to take advantage of much higher royalties on your own book sales.

What does it cost me to purchase copies of my own book?

The basic production cost is based on the number of pages. Look at our Book Pricing Schedule to get an idea of what the per-unit cost of your book will be to you. New authors receive a 44% personal discount on direct orders from us. If ordering directly, you must purchase a minimum of 10 books per order. You will also be charged for the cost of postage. To make an order, just get in touch. You will receive your books within 36 working hours of us receiving your payment.

Can I provide my own cover design?

Yes, you must with our CLASSIC Package. We will send you a graphics template which will have the trim dimensions that you will have to adhere to along with your graphical bar code, ISBN information and publishers logo. If you have any trouble, simply let us know and we will assist you as best we can. Alternatively, when you opt for the EPIC Package for £749, a customized cover for your book is included. Let us know if you would like a standalone price for a unique cover design.

How will my book be distributed?

Your book will be listed in Books in Print and the Ingram Distribution catalog. Virtually every bookstore in the world depends on those two resources to order books. It will also appear on Amazon, WH Smith, Borders, Blackwell, Tesco, Booksamillion and many other online stores.

Who's going to do the promotion of my book?

Everyone asks this question. The realistic answer is 'YOU'. You are going to either do or pay for pretty much every bit of promotion for your book. But here's the really bad news...that's true whether you publish your book yourself or you wind up with a nice, traditional, publishing contract that gives you a hefty advance and a 5000 book print run. They will expect you to spend most of your advance to promote yourself, because everyone knows that if you don't sell through that first 5000 book print run, there won't be another one. What is an ISBN, and who does it belong to?

The ISBN is the International Standard Book Number that uniquely identifies your book. In other words, the ISBN is just an identifier so that publishers, distributors and bookstores can keep it straight with all the other millions of books out there.
